Public Comments

Delia Perkins, 123 Neville St, asked the board to go through the budget and place the police

department back in the 2016-2017 budget.

Ed Bridgers, 201 Otis Avenue, asked the board to bring the police department back, look at paving Worsley Lane and Fourth Street.

Commissioner Joyner made a motion to approve the consent agenda; **Commissioner Ransome** seconded; Motion passed (3-0).

Commissioner Myrick made a motion to set a public hearing on April 25, 2016 to present the town's updated code of ordinances. **Commissioner Joyner** seconded; Motion Passed (3-0).

Commissioner Myrick made a motion to approve budget amendment #11 to the 2015-16 FY budget as presented. **Commissioner Joyner** seconded; Motion passed (3-0)

Commissioner Joyner made a motion to authorize the Town Manager to sell a former K-9 unit (dog) to former Princeville Police Officer William Barnes for the sum of \$1. **Commissioner Ransome** seconded; Motion passed (3-0).

The town is in the process of applying for a PARTF grant to renovate Heritage Park that requires a dollar-for-dollar match. The initial estimate for renovations was \$200,000 but following a needs assessment by the Parks & Recreation committee, the estimate was increased to \$300,000. **Commissioner Joyner** made a motion to adopt the Heritage Park Capital Project Ordinance. **Commissioner Ransome** seconded. Motion passed (3-0).

During the Town Manager's report, **Commissioner Myrick** asked if the town is in the process of renting the backhoe. **Commissioner Ransome** said she would like for it to be used in Southern Terrace.

Senior Center Director Linda Worsley reported that United Way awarded the center a Diamond Award for their donation to the organization.

Commissioners Comments

Commissioner Ransome thanked everybody for coming out. She said the board is listening but "we may not be able to do everything that you want us to do."

Commissioner Joyner said, "We are working on things."
