INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. Receipt and Opening of Bids

The Town of Princeville (herein called the "Owner"), invites bids on the form attached hereto, all blanks of which must be appropriately filled in. Bids will be received by the Owner at the office of Dr. Glenda Knight, Town Manager, 201 South Main Street, PO Box 1527, Princeville, NC 27886, until 11:00 a.m. local time, on Friday, July 28th, 2023, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud. The envelopes containing the bids must be sealed, addressed to Dr. Glenda Knight, Town Manager, and designated as a bid for Princeville Levee Floodgate Repairs Project.

The Owner may consider informal any bid not prepared and submitted in accordance with the provisions hereof and may waive any informalities or reject any and all bids. Any bid may be withdrawn prior to the above scheduled time for the opening of bids or authorized postponement thereof. Any bid received after the time and date specified shall not be considered. No bidder may withdraw a bid within **45** days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

2. Preparation of Bid:

Each bid must be submitted on the prescribed form and accompanied by Bid Bond in the amount of 5% of the bid, Non-Collusive Bid Certification, Certification by Bidder Regarding Equal Employment Opportunity, Form HUD-950.1, and Certification of Bidder Regarding Section 3 and Segregated Facilities. All blank spaces for bid prices must be filled in, in ink or typewritten, in both words and figures, and the foregoing Certifications must be fully completed and executed when submitted.

3. <u>Subcontracts</u>:

The bidder is specifically advised that any person, or other party, to whom it is proposed to award a subcontract under this contract:

- a. Must be acceptable to the owner after verification by the HUD Area Office of the current eligibility status; and
- b. Must submit Form HUD-950.2 and Certification by Proposed Subcontractor Regarding Equal Employment Opportunity. Approval of the proposed subcontract award cannot be given by the Owner unless and until the proposed subcontractor has submitted the Certifications and/or other evidence showing that it has fully complied with any reporting requirements towhich it is or was subject. Although the bidder is not required to attach such Certifications by proposed subcontractors to his bid, the bidder is here advised of this requirement so that appropriate action can be taken to prevent subsequent delay in subcontract awards.
- 4. Method of Bidding:

5. <u>Qualifications of Bidder</u>: The Owner may make such investigations as he deems necessary to determine the ability of the bidder to perform the work, and the bidder shall furnish to the Owner

all such information and data for this purpose as the Owner may request. The Owner reserves the right to reject any bid if the evidence submitted by, or investigation of, such bidder fails to satisfy the owner that such bidder is properly qualified to carry out the obligations of the contract and to complete the work contemplated therein. Conditional bids will not be accepted.

6. Bid Security:

Each bid must be accompanied by a bid bond payable to the Owner for five (5%) percent of the total amount of the bid. As soon as the bid prices have been compared, the Owner will return all of the bonds except the three lowest responsible bidders. When the agreement is executed the bonds of the two remaining unsuccessful bidders will be returned. The bid bond of the successful bidder will be retained until the payment bond and performance bond have been executed and approved, after which it will be returned. A certified check may be used in lieu of abid bond.

7. Liquidated Damages for Failure to Enter into Contract:

The successful bidder, upon his failure or refusal to execute and deliver the contract and bonds required within 10 days after he received notice of the acceptance of his bid, shall forfeit to the Owner, as liquidated damages for such failure or refusal, the security deposited with his bid.

8. <u>Time of Completion and Liquidated Damages:</u>

Bidder must agree to commence work on or before a date to be specified in a written "Notice to Proceed" of the Owner and to fully complete the project within **150** consecutive calendar days thereafter. Bidder must agree also to pay as liquidated damages, the sum of **\$500.00** for each consecutive calendar day thereafter as hereinafter provided in the General Conditions.

9. <u>Conditions of Work</u>:

Each bidder must inform himself fully of the conditions relating to the construction of the project and the employment of labor thereon. Failure to do so will not relieve successful bidder of his obligation to furnish all material and labor necessary to carry out the provisions of his contract. Insofar as possible the contractor, in carrying out the work, must employ such methods or means as will not cause any interruption of or interference with the work of any other contractor.

10. Addenda and Interpretations:

No interpretation of the meaning to the plans, specifications, orother pre-bid documents will be made to any bidder orally.

Every request for such interpretation should be in writing addressed to Randal Howard, Sungate Design Group, PA, at rhoward@sungatedesign.com and to be given consideration must be received at least (7) seven days prior to the date fixed for the opening of bids. Any and all such interpretations and any supplemental instructions will be in the form of written addenda to the specifications which, if issued, will be mailed by certified mail with return receipt requested to all prospective bidders (at the respective addresses furnished for such purposes), not later than three days prior to the data fixed for the opening of bids. Failure of any bidder to receive any such addendum or interpretation shall not relieve suchbidder from any obligation under his bid as submitted. 11. Performance Bond:

13. Power of Attorney:

14. Notice of Special Conditions:

- 15. Laws and Regulations:

The bidder's attention is directed to the fact that all applicable State laws, municipal ordinances, and the rules and regulations of all authorities having jurisdiction over construction of the project shall apply to the contract throughout, and they will be deemed to be included in the contract the same as though herein written out in full.

16. Method of Award - Lowest Qualified Bidder:

If at the time this contract is to be awarded, the lowest base bid submitted by a responsible bidder does not exceed the amount of funds then estimated by the Owner as available to finance the contract; the contract will be awarded on thebase bid only. If such bid exceeds such amount, the Owner may reject all bids or may award thecontract on the base bid combined with such deductible alternates applied in numerical order inwhich they are listed in the Form of Proposal, as produces a net amount which is within the availablefunds.

17. Obligation of Bidder:

At the time of the opening of bids, each bidder will be presumed to have inspected the site and to have read and to be thoroughly familiar with the plans and contract documents (including all addenda). The failure or omission of any bidder to examine any form, instrument, or document shall in no way relieve any bidder from any obligation in respect or hisbid.

18. Substitutions:

Material substitutions will not be considered during the bidding process.

19. System for Award Management (SAM):

Contractor is required to be registered in the System for Award Management (SAM) at www.sam.gov prior to Award of Contract.

20. Time Limit for Award of Contract:

The Contract shall be awarded, or all bid proposals rejected, within 60 days of the bid opening.

21. Assignments:

Neither the Contractor nor the Owner shall sell, transfer, assign, or otherwise dispose of the contract or any portion thereof, or of any right, title or interest therein, or any obligations thereunder, without written consent of the other party.
